



Leaf Motif Bangle in 15ct Gold | Openwork Design | English c.1900 POA

A beautifully crafted bracelet in 15ct gold, made in England around 1900, with a flowing openwork design of delicate leaves and softly rounded gold beads.

The naturalistic detail is subtle but deliberate, each leaf formed with light curvature, each bead placed like a bud or berry along the gold vines.

Originally a late Victorian or early Edwardian piece, its lightness and balance make it feel entirely modern. There's no heaviness here - just movement, softness, and quiet intricacy.

Worn today, it's effortlessly graceful.

Whether layered with other gold textures or worn solo on a bare wrist, it speaks of someone with an eye for design and a love of history.
