

Belt & Buckle Brooch in 18ct Gold | Sapphire, Ruby, Pearl & Amethyst Notches | English c.1900 POA

A beautifully symbolic brooch made in rich 18ct gold, this British piece dates to around 1900 and takes the form of a stylised belt and buckle, a Victorian motif traditionally associated with loyalty, protection, and eternal love.

Set into the belt's notches are four distinct gemstones, each chosen with intention and balance: a deep sapphire for truth, a vibrant ruby for passion, a luminous natural pearl for purity, and a tranquil amethyst for clarity of mind.

These stones are not merely decorative - they're anchored into the notches like values fastened in place.

Sapphire, ruby, pearl, and amethyst: four points of meaning held in gold, forming a quiet personal compass.

The final notch holds an amethyst, a gentle reminder, perhaps, that clarity of mind often comes after dessert (which the Victorians fully embraced).

A brooch for the thoughtful, the sentimental, and those who understand that wisdom and indulgence needn't be strangers.

Measuring 3cm across, the brooch is compact yet confident, a subtle emblem of devotion, designed to be worn close.

The gold catches the light with a soft, easy warmth, while the stones offer just the right depth of colour.

Elegant, meaningful, and full of character, a Victorian jewel with a surprisingly modern spirit, just as wearable now as it was then.
