

Three-Leaf Clover Brooch in 18ct Gold | Set with Ruby, Sapphire, Diamond & Pearls | English c.1900s POA

A rare and meaningful brooch, crafted in 18ct gold around 1900–1910, shaped as a three-leaf clover, a traditional emblem of faith, hope, and love.

Each leaf is set with luminous seed pearls and centred by a different gemstone: a deep sapphire for truth, a vibrant ruby for passion, and a sparkling old-cut diamond for enduring strength.

At the stem, a single natural pearl adds softness and balance.

What makes this piece special is its balance. The curved row of pearls brings a sense of movement, while the three gemstones add colour and interest.

It's thoughtful in design, personal in meaning, simple in shape, and quietly elegant.

Likely British in origin and beautifully preserved, this rare brooch is a quietly powerful piece of early 20th-century jewellery and beautifully wearable today.


