

## Diamond & Pearl Double Heart Brooch-Pendant | Blue Guilloché Enamel | English, c.1900 POA

A rare and romantic jewel from the early 1900s, this British brooch and pendant is a celebration of enduring love, crafted in rich 18ct gold in the Edwardian era.

At its heart lie two intertwined hearts, pavé-set with glittering old-cut diamonds, a symbol of unity, connection, and devotion.

The deep royal blue guilloché enamel beneath creates a vibrant backdrop, its engine-turned pattern glowing through the translucent surface like rippled silk.

A single shared diamond bridge links the two hearts, reinforcing their bond both visually and symbolically.

Encircling the design is a halo of natural pearls, perfectly spaced and gently lustrous, softening the structure and framing the jewel with quiet elegance.

Measuring 3cm across and fitted with a concealed loop, this piece can be worn as both brooch and pendant, a sign of thoughtful, versatile design.

Poetic, finely made, and full of feeling, it's a jewel that speaks of love not just remembered, but treasured.
