



Pearl, Ruby & Gold Feather Brooch | In Original Box | English, c.1900 POA

A beautifully delicate brooch in 9ct gold, made in England around 1900 and designed as a stylised feather, a Victorian symbol of hope, remembrance, and spiritual lightness.

The feather's form is built from two graceful rows of natural seed pearls, each individually set to shimmer softly along the curve.

At the base, a 0.2ct ruby adds a vibrant focal point, a flash of warmth and quiet passion that anchors the piece.

Measuring 3.5cm in length and preserved in its original fitted box, this is a brooch that carries both sentiment and style.

Light in form, rich in meaning, and as wearable today as it was over a century ago.
