An Edwardian brooch in 18ct gold, made around 1910 - simple, elegant, and quietly striking.

At the centre sits a cabochon amethyst, smooth and rich in colour, with two small old-cut diamonds on either side that catch just enough light.

The gold bar is gently ridged, adding texture without fuss.

It's the kind of piece that doesn't try too hard, it just works.

Unisex and easy to wear on a lapel, scarf, or blouse, and still full of charm more than a hundred years after it was made.

Understated, thoughtful, and beautifully made.
