



## **Pair of Silver Enamel Cufflinks | Bold Geometric Green & Black Deco Design | German c.1930s POA**

A striking pair of silver cufflinks from Germany, circa 1930, embodying the bold precision of Art Deco design at its peak.

Each cufflink is crafted in a crisp octagonal form, centred with a rhythmic run of lozenge motifs in vivid green and black enamel.

The contrast is electric - sharp, deliberate, and unapologetically modern.

These are not quiet accessories; they were made to stand out, with a confidence that feels as fresh today as it did nearly a century ago.

The stepped geometric layout is softened ever so slightly by intricate engraved detailing at the edges, a signature of the Pforzheim school of craftsmanship, where industrial innovation met refined artistry.

The silver has developed a soft patina, adding depth to the enamel's gleam and the gold-toned texture beneath.

Chain link fittings at the reverse preserve the original structure and lend a traditional touch to a thoroughly modernist design.

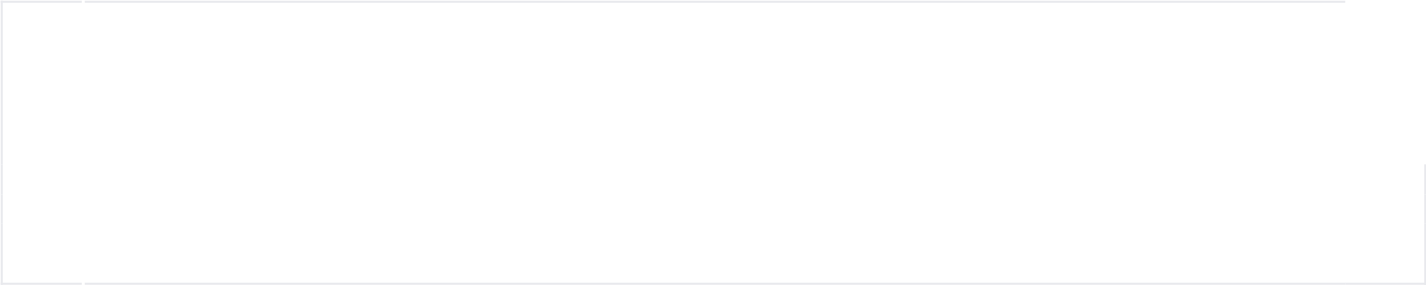
These are cufflinks for someone who understands the power of detail: elegant, architectural, and brimming with character.
