



## **Victorian Owl Stick Pin | Ruby Eyes & 15ct Gold Detail | English c.1880 POA**

A finely crafted Victorian stick pin, made in England around 1880 and modelled as a watchful little owl with piercing ruby eyes.

Cast in 15ct gold, the detail is remarkable for its size, from the soft texture of the feathers to the slight tilt of the head, there's a sense of quiet intelligence in the expression.

The ruby eyes are small but vivid, adding a flash of colour and a spark of personality.

Owls were a popular Victorian symbol of wisdom and insight, but there's also something playful about this one - a miniature character rendered with care and charm.

Worn on a lapel, tie, or scarf, it still feels relevant and expressive today.

A rare survival with just the right mix of wit, symbolism, and serious craftsmanship.
