



Gold & Enamel Lover's Knot Necklace | Amethysts & Peach Flowers | English or Austrian c.1905 POA

A rare and romantic necklace that captures the gentle spirit of early 20th-century Art Nouveau, with touches of Edwardian elegance.

Crafted in warm yellow gold and sitting high on the collarbone, the piece centres on a stylised lover's knot rendered in creamy white enamel and set with three glowing, pear-shaped amethysts.

The knot speaks quietly of unity and affection, its form both decorative and symbolic.

On either side, delicate peachy-pink enamel flowers blossom with yellow centres, adding a joyful, almost storybook charm.

Beyond them, deep purple navette-cut amethysts are set lengthways into the chain, like petals caught in motion.

The composition is balanced and softly symmetrical, full of feminine detail without tipping into sentimentality.

There's a grace to the way it sits: close to the skin, as if it was always meant to be worn with ease and feeling.

Likely made in the early 1900s, it is a piece of wearable poetry, quietly unforgettable.
