



Sapphire & Diamond Necklace | Platinum Belle Époque | French c.1910 POA

This exquisite necklace captures the delicacy and finesse of Belle Époque jewellery, likely made in France around 1910.

Crafted in platinum, it features over half a carat of old-cut diamonds and a natural 1ct sapphire suspended 3.3cm below a diamond-set bow and articulated drop.

Milgrain edging, gentle curves, and a diamond tassel lend the piece its unmistakable Parisian grace - intricate, feminine, and beautifully composed.

The 36cm paperclip chain adds a final note of French refinement, distinct from the more conservative British styles of the period.

From the icy sparkle of the diamonds to the soft blue of the sapphire, everything about this necklace feels intentional and poetic.

Romantic, refined, and full of quiet charm, it would make an extraordinary bridal piece, or a rare collector's jewel that remains effortlessly wearable today.
