



Gold & Amethyst Drop Scroll Necklace | Edwardian to Art Nouveau c.1910s POA

This necklace is a wonderfully romantic piece from the early 20th century, likely made between 1905 and 1915 during the late Edwardian or early Art Nouveau period.

The pierced gold scrollwork has a soft organic feel, with graceful details that frame the central drop beautifully.

Five faceted amethysts hang from gentle gold arches, spaced to show off their subtle mix of mauve, lilac, and blush tones.

The drops swing just slightly as you move, while the scrollwork stays still, a very elegant touch.

Romantic and easy to wear, it is very flattering and sits beautifully at the collarbone.
