



**Burmese Ruby & Pearl Cluster Ring | Victorian 18ct Gold | England

A jewel that seems to glow from within, this c.1890 Victorian ring centres a vivid, unheated 0.5 carat Burmese ruby, its deep, almost crimson hue surrounded by a perfect halo of luminous natural pearls.

The setting is striking and sculptural, but softened by the warmth of 18ct gold and the gentle curves of the raised gallery.

Look closely and you'll see real craftsmanship in the finely etched gold shank: three elegant bands with a subtle spiral texture that catch the light and give the ring a sense of movement.

It's a masterclass in late 19th-century design - romantic, balanced, and made to be admired from every angle.

A rare ring with real presence. Ring size I.
