



Three-Stone Opal & Diamond Ring | 18ct Gold | English Hallmarked 1927 POA

A beautifully balanced ring from the late 1920s, set in 18ct gold with three luminous cabochon opals and four bright diamonds.

Made in England and hallmarked for 1927, it carries all the grace and charm of its time, quiet glamour, soft lines, and a sense of joy.

The opals, with their subtle play of colour, total approximately 1.1 carats, while the antique-cut diamonds add around 0.20 carats of sparkle, just enough to lift the whole piece.

The setting is delicate and low to the finger, making it easy to wear and quietly expressive.

British-made, joyful, and full of period character - this is a ring that still feels fresh, romantic, and completely at ease.
