



18ct French Gold Signet Ring | Matte Finish & Scroll Shoulders | c.1950s POA

A beautiful French signet ring in 18 carat gold, with a satin-matte finish and scrolled shoulders. The oval face is left intentionally blank - ready for initials, a crest, or simply admired as-is.

Made in France in the 1950s, this piece reflects a quiet post-war elegance: confident but not showy, detailed but not fussy.

The soft matte surface gives the gold a warm, understated glow, while the engraved shoulders offer just enough ornament without overpowering the form.

Typical of the period, this was designed to be worn, not locked in a drawer.

The kind of ring a French professional or gentleman might have commissioned and worn daily, with subtle pride.

It would have been worn solo, often on the pinky or ring finger, and paired only with a classic watch or a set of cufflinks.

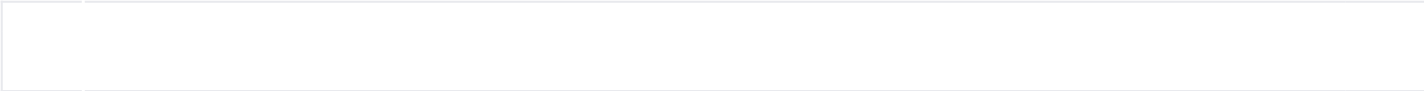
Worn today, it still reads as pure class: unfussy, timeless, and unmistakably French.
