



22ct Gold Heart Ring | Hallmarked Birmingham 1924 POA

This 22 carat gold heart ring was made in Birmingham in 1924, during the interwar years, a period marked by quiet elegance and meaningful design.

At its centre sits a small, softly contoured heart, flanked by engraved, ribbon-like shoulders that give the ring balance and subtle movement.

Fully hallmarked for 22ct gold, with the crown, Birmingham anchor, and the date letter "Z" for 1924, it also carries the maker's mark S.H, likely from a goldsmith working in Birmingham's historic Jewellery Quarter.

The choice of such high-purity gold for a modest, personal ring suggests it was a gift of care: romantic, reflective, and sincere.

Worn alone, it brings a touch of sentiment to the hand. Stacked, it adds warmth and individuality.

Over a century on, it remains quietly expressive, easy to wear, and beautifully made.
