



Austrian Silver & Chrysoprase Ring | European Deco c.1930s POA

A solid silver ring set with a smooth cabochon chrysoprase, made in Austria around the 1930s and hallmarked with the Austrian boar's head.

The setting is bold and balanced, with clean shoulders and strong geometry, a design that reflects the restrained, architectural style of European Deco, especially as it evolved in Austria during the interwar years.

The rich green chrysoprase gives the ring a soft glow against the cooler tone of the silver, and the weight and proportions suggest it was likely made for a man.

It sits comfortably in the world of Austrian modernist jewellery - pared back, well made, and quietly distinctive.

Still easy to wear today, its shape and weight give it presence without being overstated. It works well on its own, whether worn every day or when you want a piece with quiet strength and character.
