



Italian Neoclassical Chandelier Earrings | 15ct Gold with Citrines & Seed Pearls | c.1820s POA

A magnificent pair of early 19th-century Italian chandelier earrings, made circa 1820 in finely worked 15ct gold.

Each earring is a miniature sculpture - layered with coiled cannetille wire, granulation, and delicate floral elements that suspend a natural seed pearl from a warm citrine centre.

Their silhouette is grounded in Neoclassical symmetry, but their spirit is entirely romantic: golden, expressive, and full of light.

These earrings would once have belonged to a woman of means and taste in early 19th-century Italy - someone drawn to classical ideals but alive in a world of deep sentiment and social spectacle.

They would have moved beautifully in candlelight, worn for theatre, formal gatherings, or grand domestic salons.

Today, they speak just as clearly to a woman with strong personal style - someone who understands that history and craftsmanship are a kind of quiet glamour.

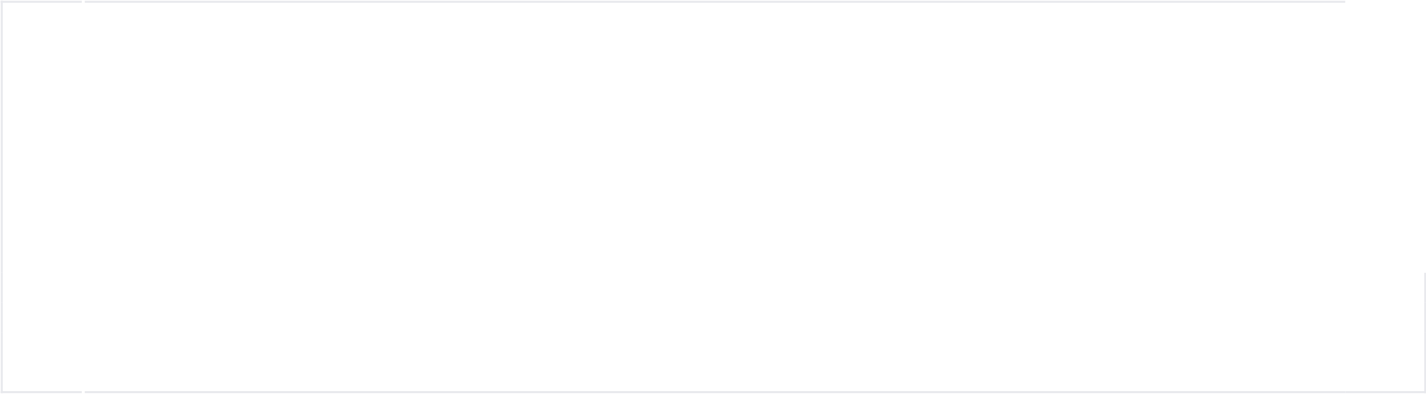
Worn with a simple silk dress or modern tailoring, they retain their poise and presence. Ceremonial, romantic, and a sharply individual signature.
