



## Victorian Turquoise Ring | 15ct Gold | c.1890 POA

A glowing example of late 19th-century design, this antique turquoise ring is crafted in rich 15ct yellow gold and set with seven cabochon turquoise stones, subtly graduating in size and colour.

The stones are held in traditional claw settings and framed by finely engraved shoulders and a scrolled gallery, all characteristic of the period's romantic detail.

Hallmarked 15ct .625, and dating to circa 1890, this piece is a beautiful representation of Victorian craftsmanship.

The naturally varied turquoise tones - ranging from sky to sea blue - add personality and depth, while the ring size Q allows it to be worn comfortably as a statement or stacked piece.

A ring like this would once have been gifted as a token of love or remembrance—and today it resonates just as deeply, ideal for a collector, stylist, or anyone drawn to antique jewellery with soul.
