



Five-Stone Turquoise Ring | 9ct Gold by H. Williamson Ltd. | English c.1930s POA

A vibrant five-stone turquoise ring set in 9ct yellow gold, crafted in Britain by H. Williamson Ltd., a respected maker active throughout the early 20th century.

With smooth, graduated cabochons framed by delicate gold beading, the design carries all the hallmarks of the 1930s Art Deco style - symmetrical, colourful, and quietly bold.

The turquoise stones are particularly beautiful - soft, even in tone, and so smoothly domed they resemble miniature duck eggs.

For anyone who loves turquoise, this is a standout example: tactile, luminous, and full of charm.

The ring is hallmarked 9ct with the maker's mark HW LD, is currently size N 1/2, and likely dates to the 1930s based on both design and period of manufacture.

It sits low on the finger and wears beautifully on its own or stacked, offering a fresh pop of colour with vintage soul.
