



Vintage Mexican Sterling Silver Sculptural Collar Necklace | c.1950s POA

A bold and sculptural vintage Mexican silver collar necklace, crafted in solid sterling silver and measuring approximately 41cm in length.

Each segment is slightly curved and graduated in size, forming a dramatic contour around the neckline.

Marked STERLING to the clasp, this piece reflects the confident, modernist design language of mid-20th-century Mexican silversmiths.

In the 1950s, a necklace like this might have been worn with a crisp shirt dress, a boat neck dress, or off-the-shoulder evening gown - clean lines, minimal fuss, letting the silver do all the talking.

Today, it's equally arresting styled with a black turtleneck, a silk slip dress, or even a tailored white shirt.

Its striking form flatters the collarbone and makes an unapologetic statement, ideal for collectors of bold design or those ready to anchor a wardrobe around one unforgettable piece.
