



## Citrine & Silver Bangle with Graduated Facets | c.1900–1910 POA

This luminous silver bangle is set with a graduated line of oval-cut citrines in rich golden hues, each stone bezel-set and separated by tiny silver beads.

Dating to around 1900–1910, its clean lines and confident structure speak to the turn-of-the-century fascination with refined materials and subtle opulence.

It's a piece that would have been worn by someone fashion-aware in the Edwardian period someone drawn to elegance with impact, favouring bold stones over frills in a time of shifting silhouettes and growing independence.

The bracelet sits beautifully on the wrist, with an interior diameter of approximately 6cm and an exterior dimension of 5cm by 6.5cm.

It opens on a discreet hinge with a satisfying clasp, making it easy to wear alone or stacked.

Its timeless palette and form make it as striking today as it was over a century ago - perfect for someone who appreciates strong lines, natural gemstones, and historical craftsmanship with enduring relevance.
