



Victorian Forget-Me-Not Ring | Turquoise & Diamond | c.1850s POA

This romantic British ring from the early Victorian era, c.1850s, is crafted in 18 carat gold and designed in the shape of a forget-me-not - a flower rich in sentiment and symbolism.

Five bright turquoise cabochons form the petals, with an old-cut diamond gleaming at the centre.

The deeply engraved foliate shoulders and unusually pierced gold shank reveal the handwork typical of mid-19th century design.
