A beautifully made sterling silver necklace from around 1920, set with ten polished amethyst beads between white enamelled bars and faceted sterling silver links.

At 148cm long, it has a fluid, versatile presence - easy to wear doubled, layered, or as one elegant line.

It would have been worn by a woman who was conscious of the changing style of the time - someone moving from the layered formality of Edwardian fashion into the cleaner lines and lighter silhouettes of the early Art Deco period.

The use of enamel, subtle colour, and thoughtful design reflects both modern taste and a refined sense of detail.

Over a century later, that same quality gives it timeless appeal.

It sits effortlessly within contemporary fashion - understated, elegant, and still worn with ease and style.

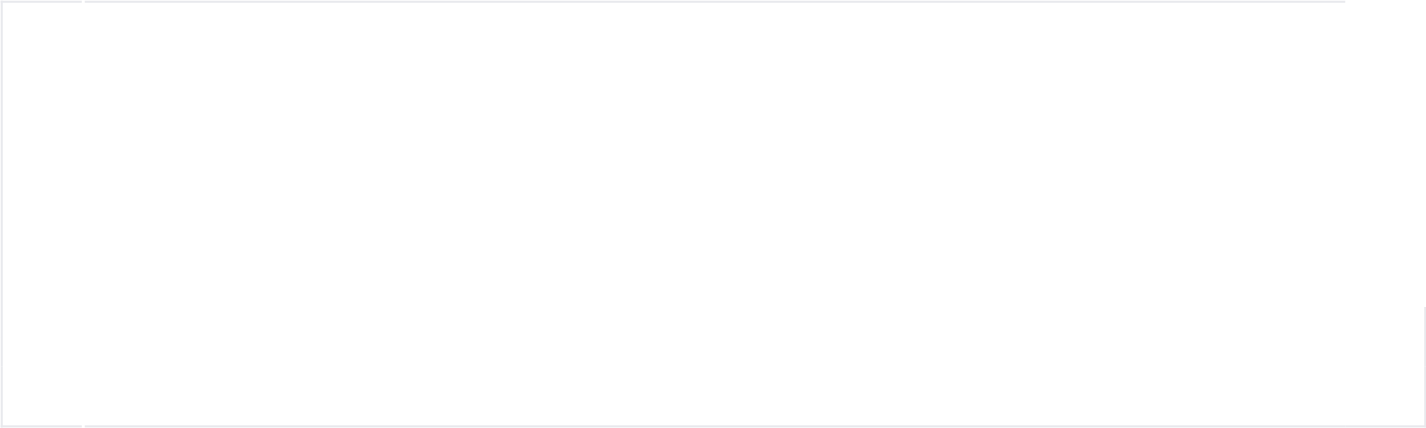
The clasp is original, and the necklace remains in excellent antique condition.
