



Coral 'Bunch of Grapes' Earrings in Silver Gilt | Italian c.1850s POA

A delightful pair of mid 19th century coral earrings, believed to have been crafted in Italy, featuring finely hand carved coral beads arranged in the form of a bunch of grapes.

They hang beneath engraved silver gilt leaf caps and a single matching coral bead, finished with French lever backs.

The design reflects the traditions of Torre del Greco, the renowned Italian centre where coral carving flourished throughout the 19th century.
