



### **Edwardian Pearl And Diamond Platinum On Gold Brooch, Circa 1910 £12,500.00**

An Edwardian natural pearl and diamond brooch, with a central natural freshwater pearl, weighing 12.11ct, with an old-cut diamond set surround, with an open framework floral motif, with millegrain edges, mounted in platinum upon gold, circa 1910.

The pin can be unscrewed and removed. There is a dropping ring at the top to allow for a pendant fitting.
