



Belle Époque Chalcedony Turquoise Brooch | French 18ct Gold with Sardonyx & Diamonds | c.1880s

An exquisite Belle Époque brooch crafted in France around the 1880s, combining softness and contrast with elegant precision.

At its centre lies a luminous oval chalcedony panel, inlaid with a scrolling botanical design in turquoise and diamond.

A border of finely carved sardonyx flowers frames the composition, creating a halo of soft blue-gray with black undertones around the pale centre - refined, romantic, and deeply expressive.

Set in 18ct gold and measuring approximately 5cm x 4cm, this is a rare and wearable jewel of the Belle Époque: confident in detail, poetic in spirit, and unmistakably French.
