



Edwardian Ruby & Diamond Heart Pendant in 18ct Gold | English c.1910 POA

Delicately romantic and steeped in Edwardian charm, this enchanting pendant dates to around 1910 and is crafted in rich 18ct yellow gold.

At its heart - quite literally - are two beautifully entwined hearts: one set with vibrant calibre-cut rubies, the other pavé-set with glittering antique diamonds.

A diamond-studded bow crowns the design, tying the two hearts in an eternal knot of affection and fidelity.

Encircled by an ornately engraved gold frame measuring 2.5cm across, the pendant has a locket-like intimacy and is filled with symbolic meaning.

The twin hearts represent enduring love, while the bow, a beloved Edwardian motif, evokes femininity and grace.

This exact piece was worn on-screen in the 2020 adaptation of Emma, connecting its historic charm to modern cinematic glamour.

Whether you're a collector of antique jewellery or simply drawn to its romantic storytelling, this pendant is a wearable heirloom with soul.
