



Art Deco Silver Necklace with Spinel & Marcasite | Theodor Fahrner | German c.1930s POA

A striking Art Deco necklace by renowned German design house Theodor Fahrner, dating to the 1930s and fully marked with "TF" and "925" for silver.

The necklace features a brilliant cut blue spinel at its centre, measuring approximately 0.9cm in diameter, set within a radiating fan motif of marcasite, classic Deco symmetry with a hint of drama.

The pendant is seamlessly integrated into a marcasite set silver chain, measuring 42cm in length.
