Q: When was Emerald Cut invented?

A: Although it is one of the oldest gem-cutting techniques, it reached mass popularity in the 1940s. Known as multi-faceted table cut at the turn of the 20th century, it came to be known as the Emerald Cut during the roaring 20s.
