Q: When was Green Tourmaline first discovered ?

A: The stone was first discovered by Dutch traders off the West Coast of Italy in the late 1600's or early 1700's. At the time, these green tourmalines were assumed to be emeralds. It wasn't until the 1800s when scientists realized that these stones were their own species of mineral.
