There's a clear sense of artistry in the composition, but it doesn't try too hard. It speaks of an era - and a maker - that valued individuality, integrity, and the quiet power of materials left a little wild.

This is a necklace with presence, made to be worn and felt rather than simply admired.

It's exceptionally rare to find an Amy Sandheim pendant complete with its original handmade silver chain, especially one in such fine condition.

These chains were not generic - they were individually crafted to complement the pendant's scale and design, forming a cohesive whole.

Over time, many were separated, replaced, or lost entirely.

This example has survived intact, with its craftsmanship, stones, and detailing beautifully preserved - a true testament to Sandheim's original vision and a rarity for collectors and connoisseurs alike.

Made in England, and unmistakably Sandheim.
