



Ruby, Diamond and Pearl Cluster Ring in 18ct Gold | c.1920s POA

This beautifully balanced 1920s ring feels like a love token, chosen with care and worn with meaning.

Set in 18ct yellow gold, its elegant form brings together two glowing seed pearls and two bright rubies, surrounded by a gentle halo of ten old-cut diamonds - each stone individually set, each one carrying its own quiet sparkle.

The design is intimate and finely scaled, sitting low to the finger with a comfortable, timeless profile.

The rubies (approx. 0.16 carats total) are full of life, while the surrounding diamonds (approx. 0.30 carats total) soften the setting with their gentle shimmer.

The hallmarked band, marked "18ct", confirms its British origin and its place in early 20th-century jewellery tradition.

Delicate yet full of heart, this is the kind of ring made for daily wear, gifted to say "always," and cherished across generations.
