



1940s Gold and Lapis Lazuli Cufflinks | Rectangular Art Deco Style POA

Bold and beautiful, these vintage cufflinks from the 1940s exemplify the mid-century taste for rich materials and precise geometry.

Each piece features a rectangular cut of lapis lazuli - intensely blue with natural pyrite flecks - set in sleek 18ct yellow gold.

The deep lapis is framed by clean, angular edges that give the cufflinks a crisp, architectural feel, balanced by a gently domed surface that catches the light.

Measuring 2.2cm by 1.2cm, they're substantial yet refined on the cuff, elevating a classic shirt with just the right note of colour and character.

The hinged backs are expertly engineered and accented with subtle linear etching, adding a layer of quiet design sophistication.

This pair speaks to the understated glamour of post-war elegance: tailored, confident, and enduringly stylish.
