



Half Hoop Sapphire Ring | White Gold | c.1970s POA

Set in 18 carat white gold, the band is channel-set with a striking row of square-cut sapphires totalling approximately 1.75 carats.

The crisp geometry of the cut stones paired with the cool-toned gold gives the piece a refined, architectural feel - almost Art Deco in spirit, but unmistakably rooted in the sleek minimalism of the '70s.

The streamlined shape and rich colour give it a strong, effortless appeal.
