The back of translucent dark blue enamel over a radially engine turned gold ground bordered by gilt and white decoration. In the centre a geometric pattern of gilt, white and iridescent green enamel set with small diamonds. The bezels set with double rows of split pearls.

An attractive watch in excellent overall condition apart from a small repair at the edge of the dial. Gold and enamel watches by Guex are found in a number of famous collections and museums.
