







Gucci Spinning Ring | 18ct White Gold | Made in Italy | c.2000s POA

This striking Italian Gucci ring is from the early 2000s iconic Tom Ford era.

Crafted in 18ct white gold, it features a rotating outer band, a smooth, kinetic detail that spins freely around the inner shank.

The outer band is engraved with the GUCCI logo, and inside, is hallmarked 750 for gold, Made in Italy, and 13 for the Italian ring size (UK M).

Spinning rings like this briefly emerged in the late '90s and early 2000s as part of a broader move toward interactive, meditative jewellery.

Discontinued and rarely seen in the market today, especially in white gold, it is satisfying to wear and unmistakably Gucci.
