



### **Edwardian Double Heart Ring with Ruby, Sapphire & Rose-Cut Diamonds | c.1910, Chester POA**

Made in England around 1910 and hallmarked in Chester, this romantic ring is set in 18ct gold and features two gem set hearts side by side, one with a ruby for passion, the other with a sapphire for fidelity.

Each heart is surrounded by rose cut diamonds, totalling approximately 0.50 carats. The ring's shoulders are subtly scrolled, and the vibrant ruby and sapphire each weigh around 0.10 carats.

Double heart rings have long symbolised romantic connection and enduring love.
