A striking mid-century butterfly brooch by the celebrated Norwegian designer David-Andersen, known for his exquisite enamelling.

Crafted in gilt sterling silver (marked 925 S), this vibrant piece features vivid green, yellow, and black enamel with beautiful guilloché detailing on the wings.

Founded in Oslo in 1876, David-Andersen became internationally recognised for designs that blend Scandinavian clarity with rich colour work.

This brooch, dating from the 1950s, measures 5.5 cm wide and 3 cm high - a wearable example of Nordic design heritage.
