





Calderoni Fire Opal & Diamond Ring in 18ct Gold & Platinum | c.1950s, Italy **POA**

Made in Milan in the 1950s by the legendary jeweller Calderoni, founded in 1840 and long regarded as one of Italy's finest ateliers, this ring embodies mid century glamour.

Crafted in 18ct yellow gold with a platinum top, it centres on a 1.25 carat golden orange fire opal, framed by a delicate halo of rose cut diamonds (approx. 0.10 carats).

Stamped 18K CALDERONI, this is a refined example of Milanese craftsmanship and timeless design.

It measures approximately 1cm across the top and is currently a UK size N½.
