



Antonio Pineda Mexican Silver & Pearl Modernist Bracelet | c.1950 POA

A bold and sculptural bracelet by celebrated Mexican modernist designer Antonio Pineda, crafted in sterling silver with inset pearls, circa 1950.

Measuring 19cm in length and marked with Pineda's signature crown hallmark, alongside TAXCO MEXICO and 970, this piece exemplifies the elegant minimalism and weighty presence that define his work.

The alternating domed links and luminous pearls create a rhythm of contrast - soft against strong, organic against architectural.

The silver has a rich patina, and the bracelet has that satisfying, deliberate weight that characterises mid-century Taxco silver.

A true collector's piece, wearable and timeless, from one of Mexico's most important silversmiths.
