



Edwardian Triple Diamond Cluster Ring in 18ct Gold & Platinum, c.1910 (1.80ct) POA

At once bold and beautifully balanced, this English ring from the 1910s is set with a total of 1.80 carats of lively old-cut diamonds.

Crafted in 18 carat gold with a platinum top, the setting frames each stone with precision, giving off a crisp glow that shifts subtly in different lights.

The three main diamonds are surrounded by smaller stones in a softly domed, graduating design, measuring approximately 2.4cm by 0.9cm across the top.

With an estimated colour of I and clarity of VS, the diamonds are bright and clean, offering antique character without sacrificing brilliance.

Hallmarked for 18 carat gold and currently a size P, this is a ring with presence - generous in scale but never overdone. It catches the eye with proportion, harmony, and light.
