



1930s Austrian Coiled Snake Ring in 14ct Gold with Ruby Eyes £1,500.00

Austrian, c.1930s, this coiled snake ring is crafted in 14 carat gold and wraps elegantly around the finger with a confident sculptural form.

The engraved scales are accented in dark enamel, giving depth and texture to the gold, while two small rubies are set as eyes - subtle, glowing, and watchful.

There's a quiet boldness to this piece: it doesn't scream for attention, but it won't go unnoticed either.

The symbolism of the serpent - transformation, protection, eternity - is timeless, and the 1930s craftsmanship gives it weight and clarity without overstatement.

Crafted in 14 carat gold and marked 585, this Austrian ring dates to the 1930s.

Coiled like a serpent in motion, it wraps around the finger with sculptural precision, its ruby eyes adding just the right glint of intrigue.

It carries a quiet confidence - striking in design, but effortless in its presence.
